opening up to each other becomes like trying to pry open a manhole cover while standing on it. The
easier way to enjoy a satisfying connection with each other requires being able to relax in each other's
presence. When you feel truly safe with each other you will naturally relax, open your heart, and an
intimate connection will occur effortlessly.

Support and encourage each other. Many marriages start off with great hopes and expectations, only to end up being disappointing, restrictive, and often hurtful. The relationship can feel as if there is not enough room for both people to be all that God desires. An ideal marriage, however, is one that provides both the opportunity and encouragement for each of you to discover and develop the fullness of what God has placed within. Know that your differences were created by God intentionally and purposefully. Learn to appreciate and delight in His handiwork as it is discovered and manifest.

Discover the romance and passion of a Christ-centered marriage. Choosing to walk with Christ and connect with His purpose positions us to engage in an uncommon adventure. Life itself moves beyond merely searching for comfort, security, and/or pleasure toward opportunities to invest our time and energy into things that also have eternal significance. We don't sacrifice the joy; we simply add meaning to it. Marriage offers the opportunity to share that adventure together. Living, learning, and loving together with purpose creates a constant source of true romance and passion that can be enjoyed for a lifetime.
